



Drought Relief Assistance Scheme

Freight subsidy application: stock returning from agistment

Instructions

Applications must be lodged with Brisbane office **within 6 months** of the date of movement.

Attach tax invoices for the cost of the return journey of all stock returned from agistment.

If claiming from the furthest point of agistment, all tax invoices and a mud map showing all movements of the livestock must be attached, including the distance travelled.

A *Waybill/s (NVD waybills)* form covering all movement/s, including the forward movement, must be attached to your claim.

If stock were forced off agistment, then the owner of the property on which the stock were agisted must provide a statutory declaration stating the period of agistment, the number of stock agisted and the reason for termination of agistment.

- sign and date the statutory declaration and have it witnessed by a Justice of the Peace
- supply a statutory declaration from the owner of the agisting property giving details of the stock, the period of agistment and proof of payment of agistment fees.

E. Applicant's declaration

I/we (full names)

in the State of Queensland, being the owner of the stock referred to on this form, do hereby declare that:

1. I am a primary producer who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from, a primary production enterprise.
2. I am a property owner, sharefarmer or lessee in the grazing industry (beef cattle, sheep, dairy cattle, goats, deer or horses that are not normally hand fed).
3. The livestock were sent to agistment while my property was within a state drought-declared area or had a current Individually Droughted Property declaration, or during the 2 month period immediately prior to drought declaration.
4. No livestock have been introduced onto this property while it was drought-declared or during the 3 month period prior to this drought declaration (includes stock taken on for agistment). If livestock have been introduced, it is in accordance with the eligibility criteria as outlined in the *Transport of livestock returning from agistment freight subsidy* guidelines.
5. My property was revoked from drought declaration prior to the introduction of any livestock. If livestock have been introduced while the property was drought-declared, it was in accordance with the eligibility criteria as outlined in the *Transport of livestock returning from agistment freight subsidy* guidelines.
6. The agisted livestock are owned by me and are returning to their property of origin.
7. The agisted livestock were grazed on my property for at least 3 months prior to their agistment and the livestock were on agistment for at least 2 months. If livestock were not on agistment for at least 2 months, my property had been revoked from drought declaration within 2 months of the livestock being agisted.
8. The distance claimed for the transport of agisted livestock was the shortest practicable route.
9. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for drought assistance, DAF will need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this claim. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
10. I understand that any applications submitted under the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme may be subject to audit by DAF or its agents in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of an audit process to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
11. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover the subsidy.
12. I have read the *Transport of livestock returning from agistment freight subsidy* guidelines available at www.daf.qld.gov.au, and this application complies with the conditions and requirements detailed in the guidelines.
