

Flood Freight Subsidy for Restocking

North West Queensland Livestock Industry Recovery Strategy

Instructions

Applications must be lodged with the Brisbane office **within 6 months** of the date of movement.

Only stock purchased after the flooding event are eligible for freight subsidy.

Tax invoices for the purchase and freight of the livestock must be provided, along with the waybills or National Vendor Declarations (NVD) used to transport the stock to the home property.

This freight subsidy is available until 30 March 2021.

Emailed photos of forms or poor quality scanned forms will not be accepted.

In the State of Queensland do hereby declare that:

1. I am a primary producer who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from, a primary production enterprise.
2. I am a property owner, sharefarmer or lessee in the grazing industry (beef cattle, sheep, dairy cattle, goats, deer or horses that are not normally hand fed).
3. My property was impacted by the North and Far North Queensland Monsoon Trough, 25 January - 14 February 2019 and due to this natural disaster event livestock on my/our property died, were lost, and/or were humanly destroyed.
4. My property was impacted by the North and Far North Queensland Monsoon Trough and my property is located in one of the following local government areas; Burke Shire Council, Carpentaria Shire Council, Cloncurry Shire Council, Flinders Shire Council, McKinlay Shire Council, Richmond Shire Council or Winton Shire Council.
5. The livestock purchased for restocking did not increase stock numbers above the numbers on hand prior to the natural disaster event.
6. I have transported the purchased livestock within 24 months of the natural disaster event.
7. The distance claimed for the transport of purchased livestock was the shortest practicable route.
8. The purchase of the livestock and the freight costs have been paid in their entirety and the necessary tax invoices are attached.
9. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for assistance, DAF will need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this claim. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
10. I agree to provide National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) data for the time period relevant to my application if requested. I understand that this information will only be used for assessment and compliance purposes related to processing and managing my application.
11. I understand that any applications submitted under this scheme may be subject to audit by DAF, the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA) or their agents in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of an audit process to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
12. I have not applied for and/or received financial assistance for the transport invoices attached to my application from either the Special Disaster Assistance Grant or the Restocking, Replanting and On-Farm Infrastructure Grant through the Queensland Rural Industry Development Authority (QRIDA).
13. I/we understand that by applying for the Flood Freight Subsidy Restocking and Agistment (FFSRA) I/we authorise and give consent to DAF to share and/or obtain information, including personal information, relating to the provision of financial assistance to me/us, including through a subsidy, grant or other similar program for the provision of funding for similar transport activities from QRIDA, QRA and/or Emergency Management Australia (EMA). Please note that DAF, QRIDA, QRA and EMA may also need to cross-reference your information from previous or current financial assistance packages, such as for restocking, replanting or infrastructure, for compliance and reporting purposes.
14. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover the subsidy.
