I suggested to her to focus her CAP application on routes which are currently available – she responded saying that none were acceptable but when pressed admitted that she believes this to be the case because she is concerned about the risk of shared use with 4WD, Car, MTB, etc. CTPI 49-Sch4 referred to an accident last year when three horses were spooked causing three riders to be thrown from their horse, one of which suffered back injuries as a result of a bike rider riding into the rear of one of the horses. CTPI 49-Sch4 agreed that she could do things to minimise the risk like employ a rider to act as a spotter but that will cost her more.
