### E. Applicant's declaration

in the State of Queensland, do hereby declare that:

1. I am a primary producer who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from a primary production enterprise.
2. I am a property owner, sharefarmer or lessee in the horticulture industry with permanent tree crops, and I own or lease the property described in section B of this form.
3. The property described in section B above is currently within a State drought declared area or has a current Individually Droughted Property Declaration.
4. I have completed a Permanent Horticulture Tree Crops – New Bores and Dam Desilting Statement which was endorsed by a Department of Agriculture and Fisheries (DAF) officer, a copy of which is enclosed.
5. I hired a contractor and incurred and paid the associated costs claimed for on this form.
6. The activity I have undertaken provides water for permanent tree crops on my property and is not primarily used for other purposes (i.e. the water is not primarily used for intensive livestock, human consumption or household use).
7. I have hired a contractor to undertake the activity and the tax invoice attached is dated within 6 months of the date of endorsement on my Statement, unless an extension has been approved by a DAF officer.
8. The work being claimed for on this application does not relate to extending or repairing an existing dam or enlarging a dam beyond its original size or creating a new dam.
9. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for drought assistance, DAF will need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this claim. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
10. I have not previously made a claim for the invoices I have detailed on this form.
11. I understand that this rebate is only available until 30 June 2022 and may end sooner if the available funding is fully expended.
12. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover the rebate.
13. I understand that any applications submitted under the Permanent Tree Crops, New Bores and Dam Desilting Rebate may be subject to audit by DAF, the Australian Government or their agents, in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of an audit process to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
