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- In June 2013, at the request of the Redland City Council, The Queensland Government declared Toondah Harbour a priority development area (PDA) under the *Economic Development Act 2012 (Qld)*. Neither Australian Government nor Queensland agencies responsible for Ramsar implementation were consulted at that stage. The PDA has an area of approximately 67 hectares including 49.5 hectares over water within the Moreton Bay Marine Park.

Sorry this took a bit longer than planned – I went down a rabbit hole this morning trying to locate some details around the Coral Area 801 and it's true definition.....

I've calculated the area of overlap between the marine park and the Toondah Harbour PDA. The outer boundary for MBMP looks reasonable in that area too. See attached map, where I also added the Ramsar area for reference.

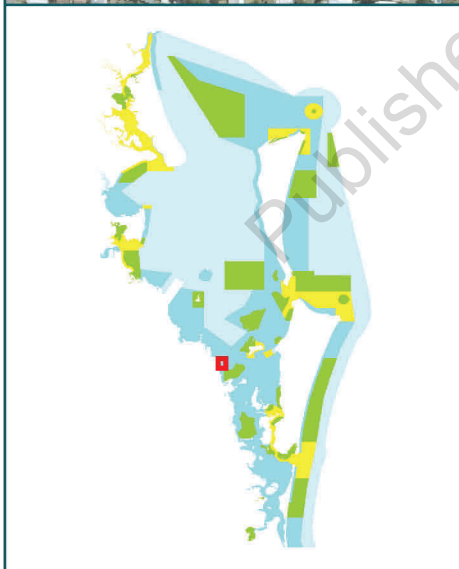
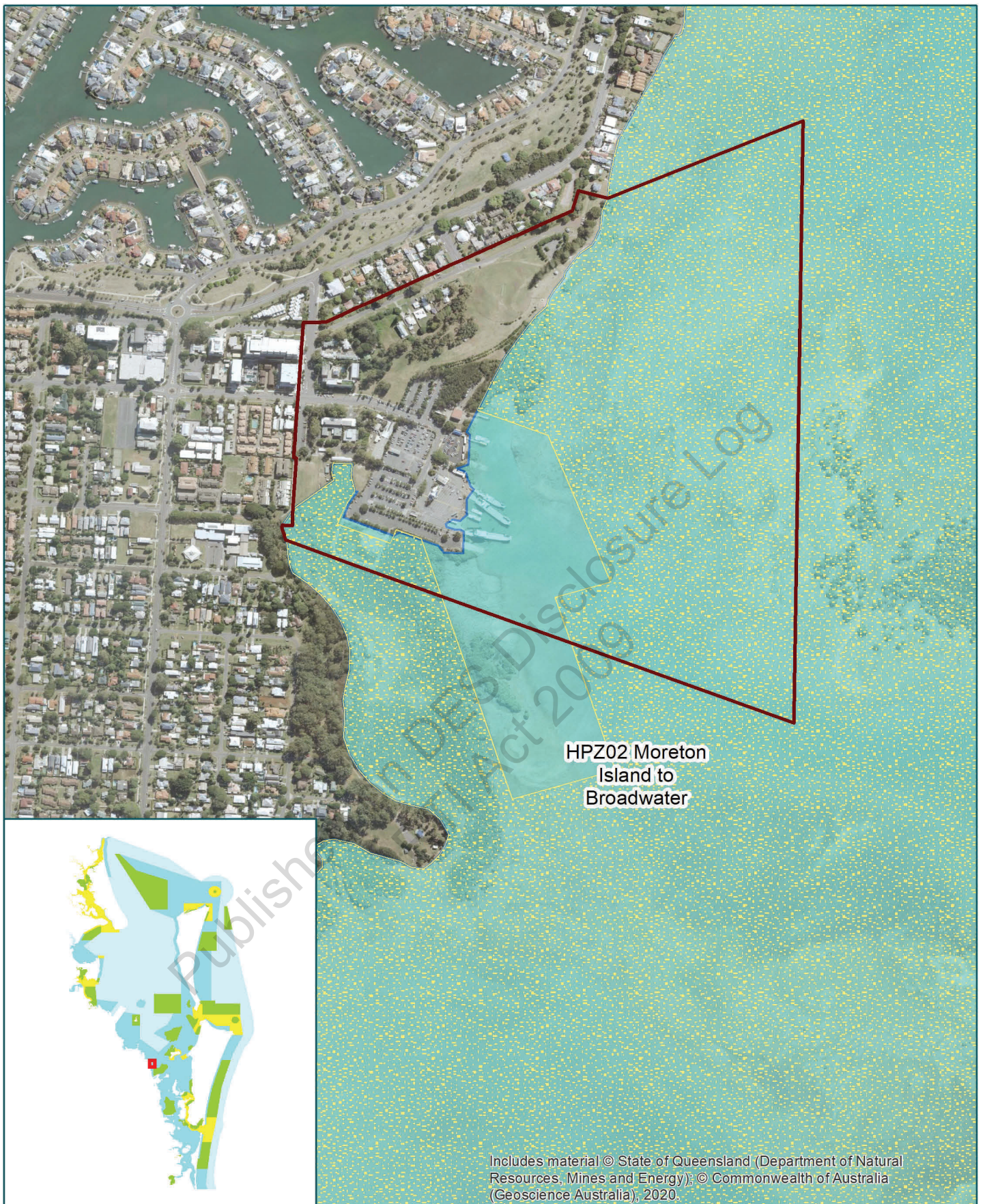
