Hi Chris,

The data you requested is in the table below. It is important to note that the total outflow volume provided are preliminary estimates only made by the Flood Team while the flood event is still in progress. There will be changes to the data when inflow into the dam and river systems for the event concludes and is accounted for, rainfall that is forecast to occur in the coming days while drain down is occurring is accounted for, stream height and rainfall electronic field data is matched against manual readings, flood model calibrations are reviewed, river gaugings undertaken during the event are examined, and the complete flood event is formally reviewed following event completion. This is why the data is rounded, and must be treated as a "preliminary estimate" to the current point in time.

Estimates that are derived from modelling are for current model calibrations to represent the current trend for current and future decision making. These model calibrations may not provide the most reliable data for the entire event. These model calibrations may change when a post event analysis is undertaken to recalibrate the models to provide information that matches the total event data

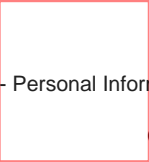
