D. Applicant's declaration

In the State of Queensland, being the owner of the stock referred to on this form, do hereby declare that:

1. I am a primary producers who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from, a primary production enterprise.
2. I am a property owner, sharefarmer or lessee in the grazing industry (beef cattle, sheep, dairy cattle, goats, deer or horses that are not normally hand fed).
3. The livestock were sent to agistment while my property was within a state drought-declared area or had a current Individually Droughted Property declaration, or during the 2 month period immediately prior to drought declaration.
4. No livestock have been introduced onto my drought declared property while it was drought-declared or during the 3 month period prior to this drought declaration (includes stock taken on for agistment). If livestock have been introduced, it is in accordance with the eligibility criteria as outlined in the *Transport of livestock returning to agistment freight subsidy guidelines*.
5. The agisted livestock are owned by me.
6. The agisted livestock were grazed on my property for at least 3 months prior to their agistment and the livestock were on agistment for at least 2 months. If livestock were not on agistment for at least 2 months, my property had been revoked from drought declaration within 2 months of the livestock being agisted.
7. The distance claimed for the transport of agisted livestock was the shortest practicable route.
8. The livestock were sent to a property for agistment in northwest Queensland that was impacted by the North and Far-North Monsoon Trough and this property resides in one of the following Local Government Areas; Burke Shire Council, Cloncurry Shire Council, Carpentaria Shire Council, Flinders Shire Council, McKinlay Shire Council, Richmond Shire Council or Winton Shire Council.
9. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for drought assistance, DAF will need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this claim. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
10. I understand that any applications submitted under the Drought Relief Assistance Scheme may be subject to audit by DAF, QRA or their agents in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of an audit process to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
11. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover the subsidy.
12. I have read the Transport of livestock to agistment freight subsidy guidelines available at www.daf.qld.gov.au, and this application complies with the conditions and requirements detailed in the guidelines.
