Hello Denise,

Thank you for your call this week.

I have undertaken a review, and the approximate annual numbers for our site are:

- Dressing
- Re-packaging s78B(2) - business affairs
- Finger-jointing

It is my understanding that no additional ERA approval is required.

This is because our site holds an approval for ERA 68 'Wooden Production Manufacturing' (see attached). I understand that this taken to be an approval for what is today ERA 48 'Timber and laminated product fabrication'. As I hold an approval for ERA 48, I understand that no approval for ERA 47 (timber milling and woodchipping) is required, because ERA 47 does not apply if I am carrying out the milling and woodchipping in association with carrying out ERA 48.

As you can understand it is hard to keep track of all of the legislative changes overtime. So if you have a different understanding to what I have described above, can you please explain it an email, so that I can get any advice I need. I will of course make an application for an ERA as soon as possible, if it is required.

Compliance Audit – ERA 47 – Timber milling and woodchipping

The Department of Environment and Heritage Protection (the department) is conducting an audit of Timber milling and woodchipping activities conducted by Baywood Products Pty Ltd (Baywood Products) at 267 Kinghorn Road, Granville Queensland 4650 (the site). It is alleged Baywood Products is operating without a relevant environmental authority.

As you are aware the threshold for Environmentally Relevant Activity (ERA) 47 – Timber milling and woodchipping is 5000 tonne per annum. At this time last year Baywood Products supplied information which indicated the quantity of material (timber) milled (includes sawing, cutting, chipping, compressing, dressing, finger-jointing and machining) at the site to be 5000 tonnes for the 2014 calendar year.

Information Request

Please supply the following information

1. Documents demonstrating the tonnage of material which Baywood Products has milled at 267 Kinghorn Road, Granville during the calendar year, 1 January 2015 to 31 December 2015.

Please provide the requested information to the department as follows:

- submissions must be made in writing;
- submissions must be sent to **EHP, PO Box 145 Maryborough QLD 4650** or emailed to widebay.esr@ehp.qld.gov.au
- submissions must be made by **18 January 2016**.

You are also reminded of your obligations pursuant to section 319 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1994*, which sets out the general environmental duty, and requires anyone who carries out an activity that causes or is likely to cause environmental harm to take all reasonable and practical measures to prevent or minimise the harm.
