ed that r As the underlying tenure is State Forest, it is suggested that DES be consulted in the first instance in relation to this reply. While the tenure is a lease under the Land Act 1994 any surrender would require consent of DES as owners of the underlying State Forest.

Background:

The Term Lease 232297 issued over Lot 251 on FY 2595 is part of the Archookoora State Forest, and as such the underlaying tenure (SF) is owned by Department of Environment and Science (DES). The lease is issued for Education purposes with an annual rental of \$272.00 plus GST.

Any surrender of the lease would be subject to approval of DES in the first instance.

eLVAS file- There have been discussions with Education since 2018 in relation to the transfer of the lease to a commercial operator. This was not supported by DES, with the most recent correspondence in March 2021, with Steve Christie, QPWS, Toowoomba.

Just wanting to run the below statement by you before sending out.

Journalist wanted this one preferably by COB today however mentioned that they weren't following up with your team until Tues morning.

The following may be attributed to a spokesperson for the Department of Education:

There are no plans to demolish the Archookoora Outdoor Education Centre.

The site is owned by the Department of Resources (DoR), previously known as the Department of Natural Resources, Mines and Energy, and is leased by the Department of Education (DoE).

Kingaroy State High School ceased using the site in 2018. As the school was no longer using the site for educational programs, they undertook a process to seek proposals from community entities for the provision of educational programs under DoE's Community Use of Facilities procedure. This procedure allows principals of individual schools to enter into agreements for community use as required.

Through this process Kingaroy SHS initiated a Community Use Agreement with Hart Consultancy that included the ongoing maintenance, utilities costs and upkeep of the centre's facilities. The Community Use Agreement with Hart Consultancy was terminated on 31 March 2023 due to DoE's intention to return the leased property to DoR. This action was supported by the school's Parents and Citizens' Association who were consulted as part of the broader decision to relinquish the lease.

DoE is preparing to engage with DoR to seek their agreement to relinquish the lease and return the land to DoR.


