

- The Department can be satisfied that due to the significantly reduced operational activities of the facility, the requested amendments will not pose an increase in environmental harm, than the environmental harm that would have been caused by carrying out the activity if the approval were not granted.
- The air quality monitoring program will continue throughout the extended term of the TEP and management measures currently in place to address dust issues will be maintained (or modified) by Ostojic as required, and
- If circumstances allow, Ostojic are committed to implementing the remaining sections of the TEP prior to the proposed extended dates.

4 Conclusion

The Ostojic's intention to continue to comply with the TEP for the Bulk Handling Facility should EHP require further clarification in relation to any of the issues discussed in this letter, please contact the undersigned or an Ostojic representative.
