

ATTACHMENT 3 – Consultation with owners/occupiers

Arrow Energy has purchased land for the purposes of constructing production facilities, which will avoid the need to involve third party landholders in the initial development stage (Fig 3A).

As development proceeds, production wells, feeder pipelines and other infrastructure may need to be constructed on the properties of third party landholders. This will be done with the appropriate landholder agreement in place, which will deal with compensation issues required under the Act, as well as environmental management issues.

Landholder agreements will be entered into upon Arrow first intending to enter a property. If the landholder requires it, a deferred agreement will be entered into. Entry to private land will be in accordance with the requirements of Part 5 of the Act.

Should works not provided for within the terms of the original agreement be required, the landholder will be informed as soon as this becomes apparent, and a new agreement entered into.

At the completion of works, or a phase of operations, the landholder will be approached and asked if there are any outstanding matters. The landholder will be provided with a checklist of items to ensure that no relevant environmental or compensatory issues have been forgotten.

Arrow recognizes that there is a need for a wider community consultation process other than with those landholders directly affected. Arrows' Land & Environment Manager will be the community liaison officer for this project and will be the central point of contact for all non-urgent community inquiries. (After hours emergency contact details will be provided to landholders in the vicinity of operations).

In order to keep the community informed, information meetings will be held with local residents invited to attend. Details of planned developments will be provided and attendees will be invited to comment on proposals or raise concerns, and encouraged to make suggestions for improvement of the project.
