



Land owner request for access or removal to industry systems (NLIS, LPA NVD)

cattle, buffalo, bison, sheep, goat, pig, alpacas, llamas

Pursuant to Chapter 7 of the Biosecurity Act 2014

When is authorisation required

When a person other than the land owner where the animals are kept:

- requires access to industry systems (NLIS, LPA NVD), or
- no longer requires access to industry systems (NLIS, LPA NVD).

Why is authorisation required

- Cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, bison, buffalo, alpacas & llamas are required to have an approved device fitted to them and the owner must create a movement record for them before they leave the property where they are kept.
- In order to comply with these requirements, it is necessary to register the animal tags and record the movement in the National Livestock Identification Scheme (NLIS) as well as obtain the relevant NVD Waybill books from the Livestock Production Assurance Program National Vendor Declaration (LPA – NVD/Waybill).
- When the person keeping the animals is not the owner of the land, Biosecurity Queensland requires the land owner, where the animals are kept, to nominate who should be given access to or have access removed from these industry systems.
