Please complete this form before claiming for the Dam Desilting Rebate.

Please note: This form must be completed by the applicant and endorsed by a Department of Agriculture and Fisheries (DAF) officer before applying for the Dam Desilting Rebate.

A copy of this form (once endorsed) must be submitted with any subsequent rebate payment applications.

Dam Desilting Rebates cannot be paid unless a Dam Desilting Statement has been approved by DAF prior to the work being completed.

Only dams specifically approved for desilting by DAF are eligible for the Government Dam Desilting Rebate.

Dams must be desilted within six months of the date of endorsement of this application.

Completion of this form does not guarantee approval or payment of the desilting rebate.

1. Copies of quotes for all dams you propose to desilt and claim for the Dam Desilting Rebate. Quotes are to specifically mention dams by name and paddock location, and would need to detail the basis for the estimated maximum total cost (e.g. #/m³ of material removed, \$/m³ of material removed etc).
2. A current photo of each dam to be desilted. It is suggested that photos be numbered in relation to each dam and capture the entire normal water storage area in the one shot (no part pictures) and should include a vehicle, beast, person, or similar within frame to give assessors a better idea of scale.
3. A map of your whole property clearly showing the location of all dams intended for desilting and rebate claim. Name or number of paddocks and dams as required to make identification and location clear. Property maps can be hand drawn.

E. Applicant's declaration

1. I am a primary producer who normally spends more than 50 per cent of my labour on, and derives more than 50 per cent of my gross income from a primary production enterprise.
2. I am a property owner, sharefarmer or lessee in the grazing industry (beef cattle, sheep, dairy cattle, goats, deer or horses that are not normally hand-fed), and I own or lease the property described in section B of this form.
3. The property described in section B above is currently within a stated drought declared area or has a current Individually Droughted Property Declaration.
4. I understand that endorsement of this form by DAF entitles me to apply for the Dam Desilting Rebate but does not mean an automatic payment of the rebate.
5. I understand that this rebate is only available until 30 June 22 and may end sooner if the available funding is full expended.
6. I understand that completing this form does not guarantee access to funding for the Dam desilting rebate as the funding may be exhausted at any time.
7. In order to assess my claim and make an informed decision on my eligibility for drought assistance, DAF will need to confirm the details provided on this form with the details previously provided as a Registered Biosecurity Entity. These details will not be accessed or used for any other purpose other than to assist in assessing this claim. I consent to authorised officers accessing and confirming my details in the Biosecurity Entity Registration System.
8. The information I have provided in this application and in supporting documentation is, to the best of my knowledge, true and accurate. I understand that providing inaccurate, untrue or misleading information may be a breach of criminal law, for which serious penalties may apply. I also understand that if any information I have provided in the application or supporting documentation is found to be inaccurate, untrue or misleading, legal action may be taken against me, including action to recover the rebate.
9. I understand that any applications submitted under the Dam Desilting Rebate may be subject to audit by DAF, the Australian Government or their agents in order to determine compliance with scheme guidelines. By signing this declaration, I understand that I may be asked to provide further information in regards to my application and/or the material submitted with my application and that I may be requested to allow a property inspection by DAF as part of an audit process to determine compliance with scheme guidelines.
