

Implementation of the *Environmental Protection Regulation 2008*

The Queensland Government has amended the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* and remade the *Environmental Protection Regulation 2008*. The Department of Environment and Resource Management (DERM) is responsible for implementing these legislative changes, which took effect on the 1 January 2009. The major changes are set out in the document *Environmental Regulations — Update for Operators* (attached).

The attached annual notice lists the environmentally relevant activities (ERAs) from the new Regulation that, from the 1 January 2009, apply in place of the former ERAs listed on the environmental authority or registration certificate, applicable to your business.

Fees will continue to be charged on the basis of the highest annual fee for an ERA covered by an environmental authority or registration certificate.

The transition from the old ERAs to the new ERAs was based on the following information, in order of preference:

- Production levels set in the development approval/environmental authority where available;
 - Production levels specified in the application for development approval/environmental authority where available; or
 - Actual production figures; where available.

The ERAs in the annual notice should reflect the activities that were approved at the time an environmental authority or development approval was issued. In the case of mining and petroleum activities the listed ERAs are ancillary to the mining and petroleum activities and they will be amended administratively to reflect the new ERAs.

If a business with a registration certificate now operates a different ERA or at a higher threshold, a Material Change of Use Application will be required. Please contact DERM to discuss how to make such an application.

You should check the new ERAs listed in the attached annual notice and complete the attached certification and return it to:

If you agree with DERM's assignment of the ERAs, the registration certificate will be amended to reflect these ERAs.

If you consider that any of the ERAs have been incorrectly assigned, please indicate the changes necessary on the attached certification (together with details of why you consider these changes are needed). You may contact the local DERM office to discuss the changes prior to completing the certification.

There are a number of ERAs that have been deleted and no longer apply. A registration certificate or environmental authority will not be required for these ERAs from the next anniversary day after 1 January 2009. If you are operating one of these ERAs it should have been removed from your registration certificate and would not have appeared on your annual notice.
