Important information for applicants

This form is to be used to apply to end the declaration of a designated animal as a restricted animal.

Information requested will enable the application to be processed as prescribed by the *Biosecurity Act 2014*. The application must be assessed by the chief executive.

To make an application the applicant must be the:

- occupier of the place where the restricted animal is kept; or
- owner of the restricted animal; or
- registered biosecurity entity for the place where the restricted animal is being kept.

- Payment of prescribed fee must be paid at the application submission for it to be processed.

Requirements for application

The applicant must:

- outline any steps taken to ensure the restricted animal, does not pose a biosecurity risk; and
- include evidence (for example, reports prepared by suitably qualified persons) the restricted animal does not pose a biosecurity risk.

Inquiry about application

Before deciding the application, the chief executive may, by notice to the applicant, require the applicant to give the chief executive, within the reasonable period (of at least 30 days) stated in the notice, further information or a document the chief executive reasonably requires to decide the application.
