Important information for applicants

This form is to be used to apply to end the declaration of a place as a restricted place.

Information requested will enable the application to be processed as prescribed by the *Biosecurity Act 2014*. The application must be assessed by the chief executive.

Eligibility

- The occupier of the place; or
- The owner of the place; or
- Any entity that is, or is reasonably expected to become, a registered biosecurity entity and for whom the place is, or is reasonably expected to be, for the entity's registration, a designated place.

Prescribed fee

- Fees are applicable until the end of the financial year.
- Payment of prescribed fee must accompany the application for it to be processed.

Requirements for application

The applicant must:

- outline any steps taken to ensure the restricted place, does not pose a biosecurity risk; and
- include evidence (for example, reports prepared by suitably qualified persons) the restricted place does not pose a biosecurity risk.

Inquiry about application

Before deciding the application, the chief executive may, by notice to the applicant, require the applicant to give the chief executive, within the reasonable period (of at least 30 days) stated in the notice, further information or a document the chief executive reasonably requires to decide the application.
