
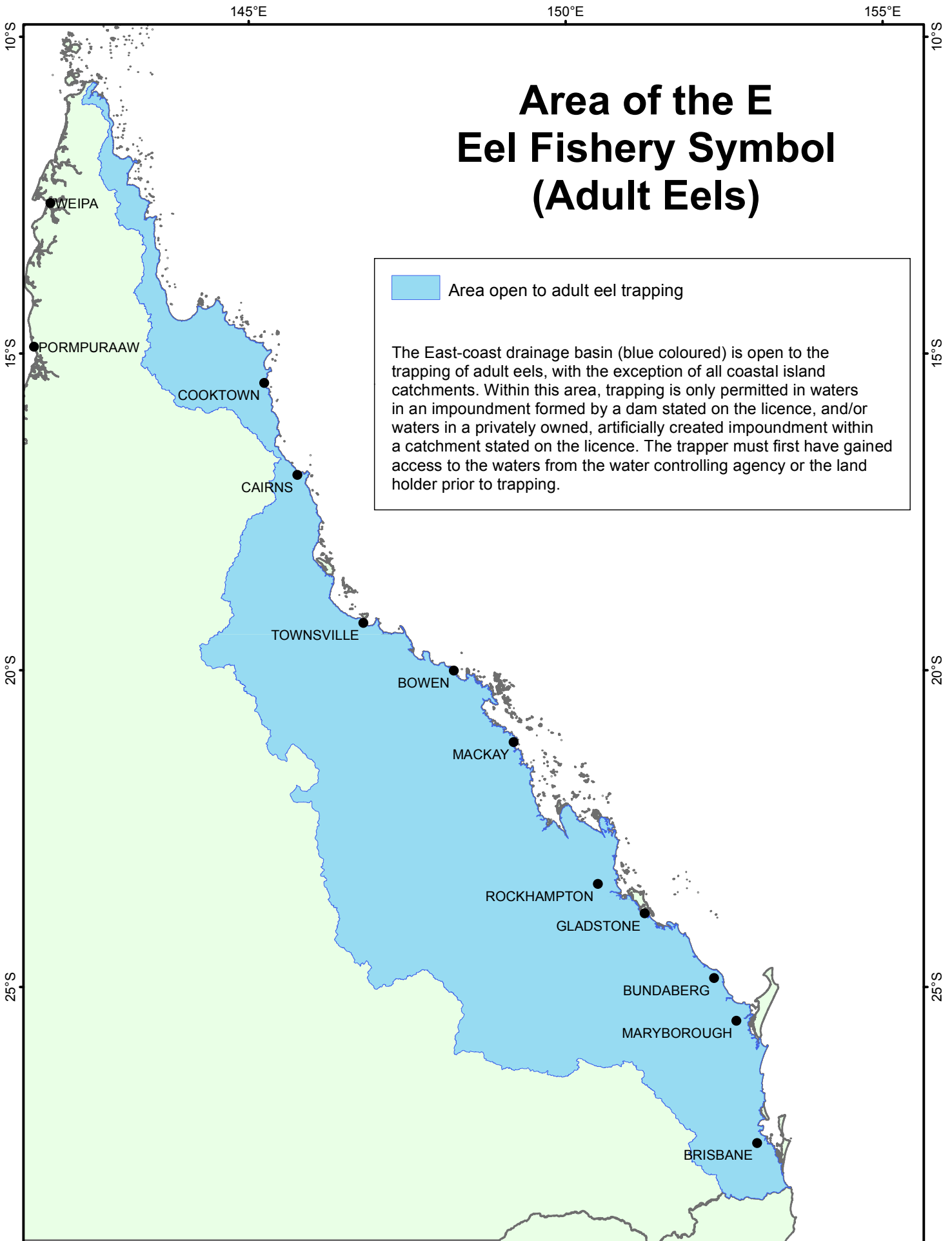


# Area of the E Eel Fishery Symbol (Adult Eels)

 Area open to adult eel trapping

The East-coast drainage basin (blue coloured) is open to the trapping of adult eels, with the exception of all coastal island catchments. Within this area, trapping is only permitted in waters in an impoundment formed by a dam stated on the licence, and/or waters in a privately owned, artificially created impoundment within a catchment stated on the licence. The trapper must first have gained access to the waters from the water controlling agency or the land holder prior to trapping.
